Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)

I would like to inform you of our Summer uniform policy which starts on Monday 5 June 2017 on our return to school after half term. Please note if the weather is forecast to be hot then students will be allowed to come to school without their blazer. However, jumpers may not be worn as a substitute to the blazer. Shirts and blouses should continue to remain tucked in at all times in order to maintain a smart and presentable appearance. If the summer temperatures become very warm, students will be permitted to remove their ties once they arrive at school. Please ensure that all ties are labelled with your child's name clearly marked. Senior girls (Year 10 and 11) may wear a regulation open neck blouse without a tie – only one style available from our uniform suppliers.

This year, in addition to our uniform, boys may wear the prescribed grey tailored "Trutex" shorts which can be purchased from Children's Choice (Belper) or Uniformity (Borrowash). Girls can continue to wear either grey or black knee length skirts of the prescribed style which can be purchased from both uniform suppliers. There is no change to our footwear regulation.

Summer Uniform Summary

In the event of hot weather from Monday 5 June until Friday 21st July, please be aware of our optional summer uniform which may be worn.

Girls and Boys

- White short sleeved shirts/blouses (tucked in at all times)
- Prescribed JFCS tie worn to the top. Can be removed in very hot weather.

Senior Girls

- Regulation open neck blouse (one style available from our uniform suppliers)

Girls

- Regulation black skirt must reach the knee when standing.
- It is not compulsory to wear tights, white or black knee/ankle length socks can be worn.

Boys

- Regulation grey tailored 'Trutex' shorts

There is no change to our footwear policy for the summer, footwear must be sturdy, suitable and **completely black** shoes for school.
