Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)

Your child has expressed an interest in a trip to Geneva in July 2019 to visit CERN – the home of the Large Hadron Collider.

At present, the plan is to fly to Geneva on Friday 5 July, to arrive in Geneva in time to visit the Place du Nations, with a meal afterwards nearby including a tram ride back. Our overnight accommodation will be in the Geneva Youth Hostel. Over the weekend, we will visit CERN and have a guided tour and an opportunity to visit the permanent exhibitions. Other attractions on the trip will include the History of Science Museum, Botanical Gardens, the Baby Plage with a water taxi across Lake Geneva and a climb up St Peter's Cathedral.

Breakfast and evening meals are included within the price, although lunches are not, nor is food during travel. Lunch on one day will be in the CERN restaurant, which is very good value for money offering self-service with a wide choice of food, prices will be from £12.00. An alternative lunch venue is the café in the Botanical Gardens where prices are between £10.00 and £18.00. Students will need to take local currency to cover the cost of these meals, but it was judged to be a better value option than a packed lunch provided by the hostel and this is reflected in the price of the trip.

The itinerary will be dependent on the flights that are booked and the availability of tours at CERN which cannot be confirmed until we have final numbers for the visit, therefore details may change, as may the cost, although I have hopefully erred on the side of caution.

The dates will be Friday 5 July 2019 to Monday 8 July 2019.

The full cost of this trip will be £480.00 (subject to change), with four monthly payments of £120.00. Please be aware the full amount must be paid by the end of February 2019.

If you would like your son/ daughter to go on this trip, please would you return the reply overleaf to reception by Friday 8 November 2018 with either cash or a cheque (payable to JFCS) for £120.00 - please note this is a non-refundable deposit to secure your child's place.

Places are limited and I strongly advise that returns are made as soon as possible.
